Winemaking Notes:

With only 90 cases produced, the 2009 Petite Sirah was made exclusively for our wine club and tasting room. This elegant Napa Valley Petite Sirah was made with fruit sourced from vineyards located in the Yountville and Oakville appellations. The 2009 harvest was an outstanding season for growing grapes in the Napa Valley. Rainfall in late spring

followed by a warm spell in early summer created the perfect growing conditions required to produce a stellar vintage. Overall, 2009 was a relatively cool season that created evenly ripe fruit with complex flavors and intense character.

This wine was aged for fourteen months in second fill American oak barrels to enhance the natural spice of this varietal.

Tasting Notes:

The wine offers lovely aromas of fresh blueberries and blackberries. Lush red cherry fruit lingers on the palate, accented by hints of cardamom. The finish is alive with juicy fruit flavors.

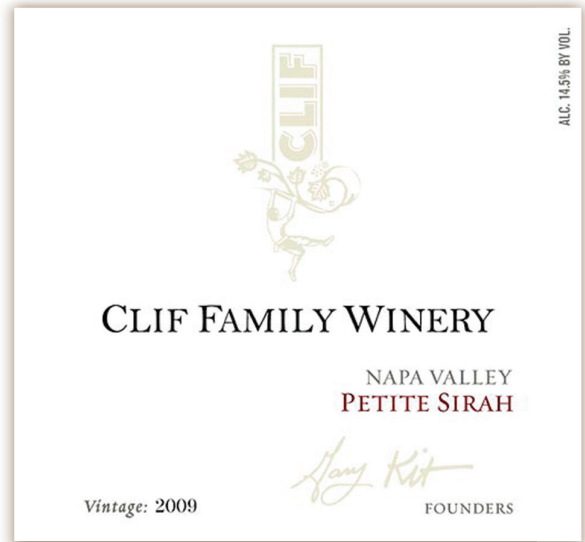
